

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. How do I change a game?

All game changes must be made by using the Game Change Form. This form can be found on the MUSL website (www.musl.net). From the website, select "Forms", and then, Game Change Form. Fill out the form and select "Send", the form will go directly to a special email set up for game changes. There is a \$5 charge for all game changes.

2. How do I add a player to my roster?

If the player that you wish to add to your roster is new to the league, then the player must come to the MUSL office and have his picture taken and his ID checked. If the player is currently playing in the league in another Age Group, or has played in the league since 2003 but is not currently playing for any team, then you must use the ART Form (Add, Release, Transfer Form). This form can be found on the MUSL website (see above). Fill out the form and fax it or mail it to the office. Our fax# is: 248-288-3889. 3. How do I release a player from my roster?

To release a player from your roster, you must use the "ART Form". Fill out the form and mail the form along with the players pass card to the MUSL office. No release can be completed without the return of the pass card.

4. How do I transfer a player?

To transfer a player to your roster you must use the "Art Form". Fill out the form and mail the form to the MUSL office. The transferring player must get his pass card from his old team and either mail it or bring it to the office before the transfer can be completed. There is an eight day waiting period for all player transfers. See Rule 3.3.4 and 3.3.6 found on page 11 of the MUSL Rule Book.

5. What do I do if the referee fails to return my pass cards after the game?

6. Do I have to pay the referees if the other team doesn't show up for a game?

Yes, you have to pay your half of the referee fee (currently \$70).
